



2022 Miracle on 7th Street Christmas Tree Decorating Contest Presented by The Hometown Savings Bank

Miracle organizers are excited for the Miracle on 7th Street to be back in 2022! The event will begin on Friday, December 2nd, from 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm, and reopen on Saturday, December 3rd, from Noon to 5:00 pm. **The *Miracle Christmas Tree Decorating Contest* is open to all non-profit organizations within the Wabash Valley.**

Twenty live evergreen trees (stands included) are donated by the Breakfast Optimist Club. Area non-profit organizations are invited to sign-up to decorate a tree with their own Holiday Spirit signature. There is no fee to enter the contest. Entrants are on a first-come basis.

The decorated trees will be located at 7th and Wabash near the Vendor Market tents. Unfortunately, due to space restrictions, the trees will not be undercover and exposed to the elements, therefore, plan your decorations accordingly. It is the responsibility of the participating organization to provide all decorations. Judging of the trees will take place on Friday, December 3rd with one grand prize winner of \$500. All other participants will be awarded \$100. **THE CONTEST WINNER WILL BE ANNOUNCED AFTER JUDGING AND AWARDS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE PARADE ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 3RD.**

CONTEST RULES & GUIDELINES:

1. The completed registration form must be received by November 29, 2022. Entrants can scan and send electronically to **Carol Britton at wetherellc62@gmail.com**
2. All decorations are to be provided by the participating organization, and **MUST** include lights. The organization's name CANNOT BE VISIBLE until after the trees are judged. Trees will be available for decorating at 1 pm on December 2nd, and must be decorated by 4:30 pm that day.
3. No display tables are allowed, however, organizational brochures or fact sheets may be made available for those who ask after judging.
4. Judging will take place at 5:30 pm, Friday. After judging of *Miracle Trees*, winners will be announced and participating organizations can then display their name. Award presentation (check distribution) will be held at the commencement of the Light Your Way Parade on Saturday, December 3rd at 6pm.
5. **All trees must be disassembled and removed by Noon pm on Sunday, December 4th.** If a tree remains after Noon, the tree and decorations will be discarded.
